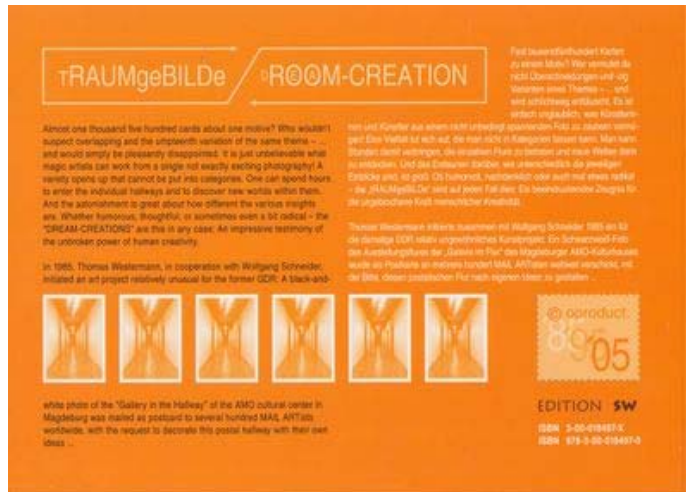


# ruud janssen - iuoma & tam

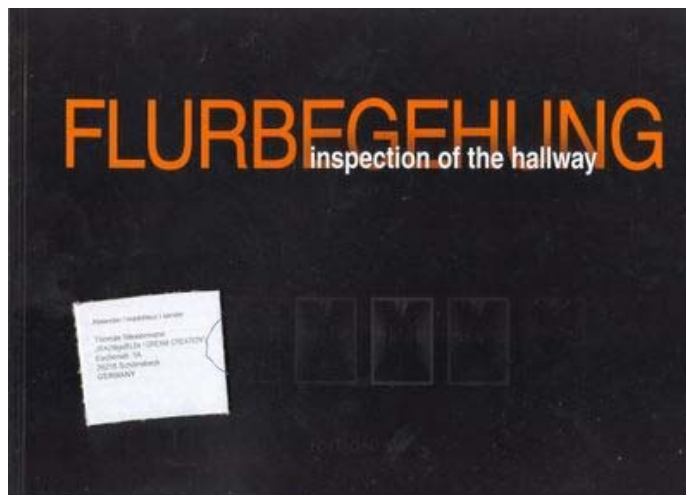

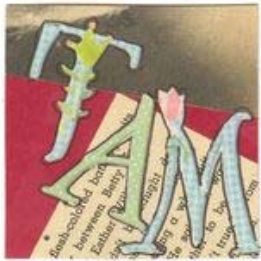

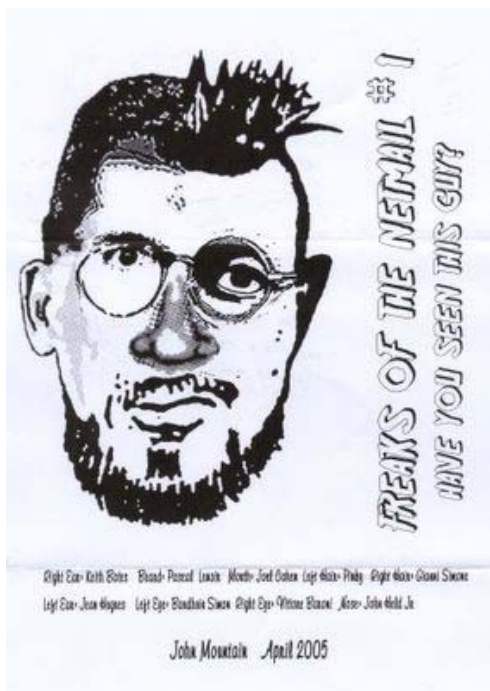

### John Puig - Barcelona - Spain.



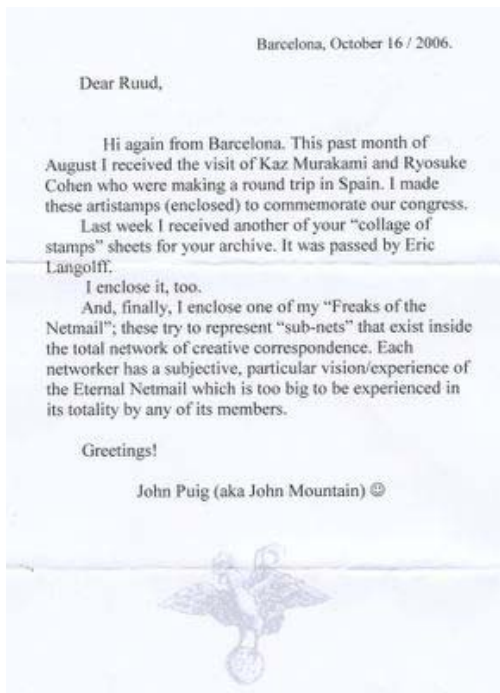

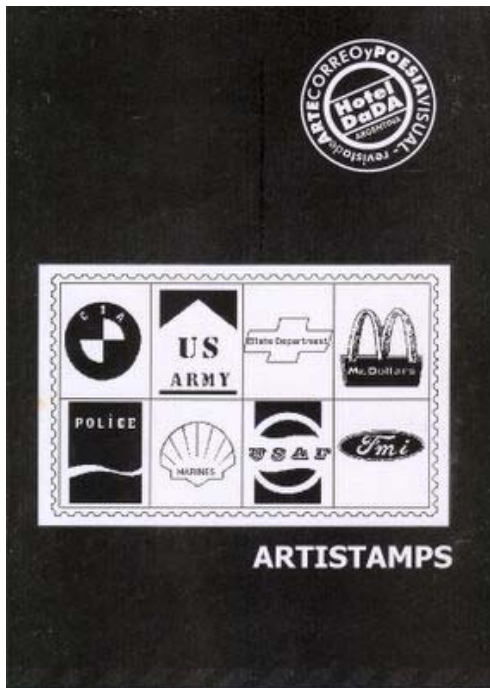

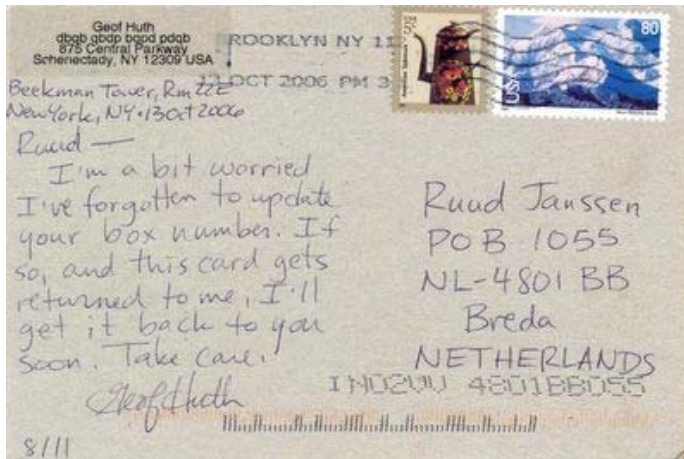

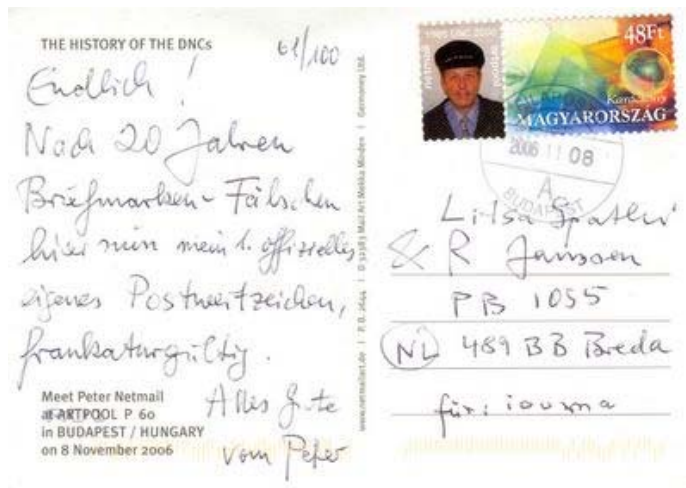

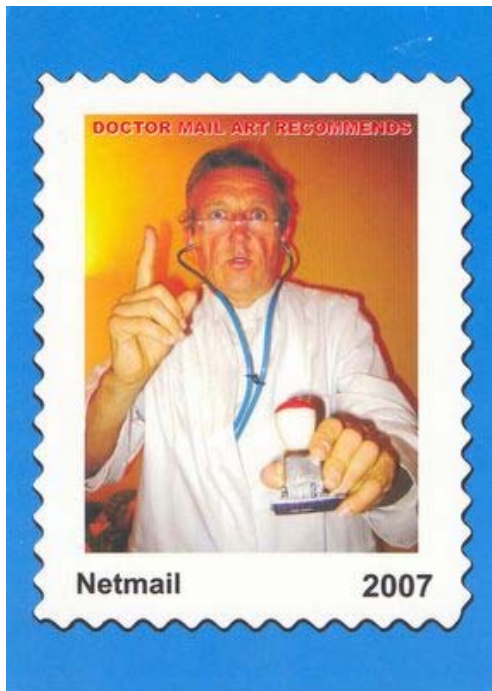
