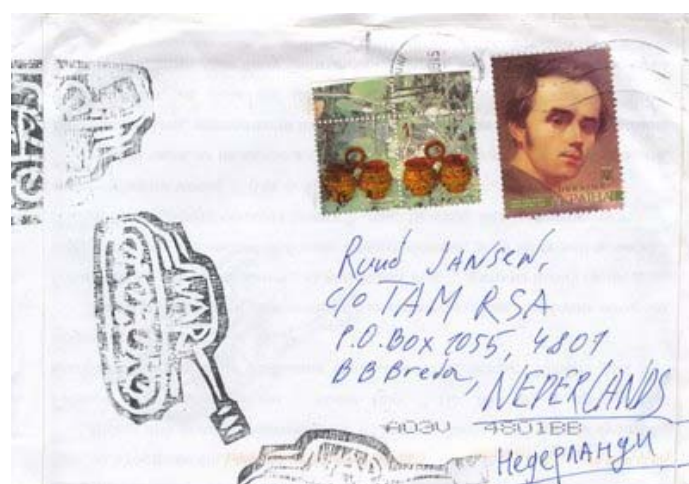

Dear Networker:

Greetings and thanks for all your wonderful mail, a bumper crop of postcards, as you shall soon see. It's been a busy year starting in February with artist talks at San Jose University and a solo and workshop at the San Francisco Center for the Book. After buying my head against a wall of silence about doing the Banana Oblique-Pipe in Vancouver next year, I abandoned the idea in favor of hanging my head against another wall: my efforts to interest a number of institutions in taking on the video archive of my events and performances. Since 1975 Banana Oblique-Pipe to the Deaf-Hand-on-Me event in Berlin in 2003. However, as they say, power-area further, and there is a glimmer of hope on the horizon on that front at least. I'll say no more about that until such time as I have something definite to report.

In the meantime, I've been taking stock of my collection of mail-art publications. While I still have one closet to go through, the bulk of the collection looks like this: *Periodicals*: 1970s-2007, 1980s-2006, 1980s-2006, and so far in the 2000s-2007. *Exhibition project and event catalogues*: 1970s-1980, 1980s-1984, 1980s-1985, and in the 2000s-2007. *Books*: 1970s-2006, 1980s-1984, 1980s-86, and in the 2000s-2007. The most difficult parts of this process has been finding a year date to them, and determining whether it is a book or a catalogue. The most difficult decision I made, was to keep the catalogues, books and reviews about artist-art exhibitions with the four boxes of artist-stamp I've had separately from other mail-art printed matter... and I haven't done the main of these as yet. The next step in all of this, the tedious task of re-organizing this material, one which will likely have to wait until next summer.

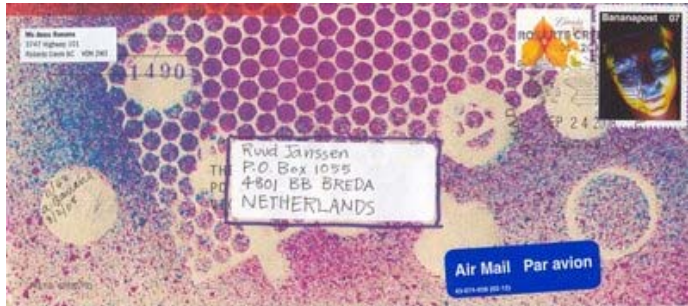
While the exhibit of *Seaview Blackbirds* June 1st happened due to a lack of exhibition space available to the Edmonton Small Press Association, a number of other events requiring work and planning are now on the horizon, including the upcoming issue of *International Art Post*. Besides workshops in October, February and March, here and home sitting in fish for my daughter, I'll be participating in a group exhibition in May. *Alternate Materials* curated by Ed Varney, at the Evergreen Center in Port Capitan, and a solo exhibit April 20th July 5th at the Weyersburg Museum for modern Kunst in Bremen, Germany.

I am currently working to get some dates in April, in Europe, to present a more, interactive work, that is *As it Happens*. Nothing has materialized up to yet, but I am friends in Dortmund, Holland, Berlin, and Barcelona are currently making enquiries on my behalf. If any of my other European friends have access to gallery space/corridor's etc., let me know. This event needs space in a plaza or street adjacent to a gallery/exhibit room. I'll bring the visuals on a CD so they can be projected from a computer or printed out, so they can be looked at a wall or hung on a line in the space. These would not be an "exhibition" as such, but part of an evening's event.

The MATA "Guest talking banana," and proposed by me) Banana Museum, have gone silent on me. After all, the folks on the Tourism Committee are not mail artists! For those who didn't receive *Banana Rag* 37, a brief summary of this story: the town of Medina, Manitoba, population 1100, decided they needed something BIG to attract tourists. The Tourism Committee was formed and came up with the idea of building a giant, talking, eating banana to do the job. Others in the town thought a giant bird, or cat or even would be more appropriate. A controversy ensued, which caught the attention of the media, and one of the committee was interviewed on CBC's *As it Happens*. I heard that, and phoned to offer my entire banana collection to the town IF they would establish a museum to house it, as institution that would justify the statue AND draw curious tourists. Members of the committee visited me to deliver copies of their press coverage. After reading the objections (it should be something that represented the area: birds, corn), I redesigned their banana figure from one with hands on hips, to one with hand extended in greeting, with a hand alighting on its palm. The region, known for birds and it's warmer weather, is known as the "Banana Belt" of Manitoba. Unfortunately, committee members are not mail-artists, so I have had no response to my museum offer or the redesigned banana. Anyone out there wanting a great little tourist attraction? 27 years worth of banana items? Let me know!

Meanwhile, I'm hoping to receive your images for LAMP 21 in the mail before the October 21. Gotta split now, Anna
