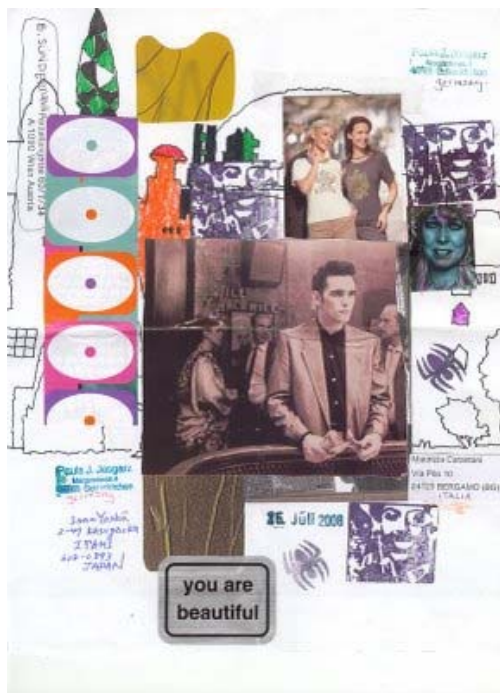

#### ETHEREAL OPEN NETWORK ARCHIVE MAIL ORDER 2008

My mail art archive, that would later take the name of E.O.N. (Ethereal Open Network) archive, was started in 1977 and quickly grew from being just a small collection of files in my bedroom library to filling several rooms, basements and garages. It is now stored in four rooms of my house in Vianen, using up entire walls and shelves and ordered in hundreds of envelopes and bags and dozens of boxes of various shapes and sizes. Only one possible on appointment only.

I have tried to preserve in the archive, throughout the years, a few copies from 2 or 3 up to 10 or more, depending on availability of each book, record or publication that I produced (newspapers, journals, leaflets, etc.). Some of these publications have been now sold out for decades and can only be found through collectors' sets or on eBay at ridiculously high prices. If you are interested in some specific item from my past, ask and I may be willing to part from one rare copy, but expect collector's prices appropriate to the scarcity and future of the products.

A few items, listed in this leaflet, are not available in small quantities. I also have in the archive double copies of several mail art books and catalogues received through the years.
